

REGISTRATION PROCESS FOR THE TRAINING ON PRE-ANALYTICAL ISO STANDARDS 20184 | 20166 | 20186

How to access the web conference series (two steps):

1) Registration at online Google document(s)

2) Registration at GoToWebinar (online conference software)

1) Google document(s)

For the Google document(s) registration you need to have the ISO standards next to you, because you need to fill out - next to general information - a specific password query. This password is an explicit number/word that can be found in the text of the relevant ISO standards 20184:2018, 20166:2018, 20186:2019. This procedure is mandatory, because the standards are ISO licensed documents which cannot be shared publicly in web conferences (Copyright protected documents, all rights reserved by ISO). The password is your personal key for the registration to the web conference series. Please treat your access data as confidential and do not pass them on to third parties.

Please register either for single, multiple or all three ISO standards, depending on which sessions you want to participate in

- Frozen tissue (FT) 20184:2018: Please follow this link.
- Formalin-fixed and paraffin-embedded tissue (FFPE) 20166:2018: Please follow this link.
- Venous whole blood (VWB) 20186:2019: Please follow this link.
- ALL SESSIONS (FT, FFPE, VWB): Frozen tissue 20184:2018, Formalin-fixed and paraffin-embedded tissue – 20166:2018, and Venous whole blood – 20186:2019: Please follow this link.

2) GoToWebinar
